Computerized Provider Entry §170.314(a)(1)	Enables users to electronically record, change, and access the following order types: Medications, Laboratory, Radiology/imaging, other Ancillary orders, Nursing Orders	A one-time implementation service fee and a recurring monthly maintenance fee applies per install. Separate one time interface fees may apply for laboratory, radiology and pharmacy systems, along with annual cost for ongoing support of interfaces, may apply.	No contractual limitations	Minimum hardware specifications apply
Drug-Drug, Drug-Allergy Interaction Checks §170.314(a)(2)	During computerized provider order entry (CPOE), interventions automatically and electronically indicate to a user drug-drug and drug-allergy contraindications based on a patient's medication list and medication allergy list.	A recurring monthly maintenance fee applies for the use of First Data Bank database support for pharmacy.	No contractual limitations	Minimum hardware specifications apply
Patient Specific Education §170.314(a)(15)	Patient-specific education resources. MEDHOST EDIS electronically identifies for a user and patient-specific education resources based on data included in the patient's problem list, medication list, and laboratory tests and values/results. Customers may choose to use the Info-button feature, which pulls content from the National Library of Medicine.	A one-time implementation service, license, and a recurring monthly maintenance fee apply for ExitCare Complete. Monthly fees are based upon number of licesned beds.	No contractual limitations	No technical or practical limitations
Transition of Care §170.314(b)(2)	MEDHOST EDIS creates and transmits electronic transition of care/referral summaries.	A one-time implementation service and recurring monthly maintenance fees apply. Monthly maintenance fees are flat fees. Base licensing and subscription fee includes up to 10 seats (1 seat per registered clinician or user). Additional seats can be licensed under an additional subscription fee in lots of 10 seats. MEDHOST maintains all contractual agreements with supported HISP, Secure Exchange Solutions. Customers are not required to maintain independent 3rd party agreements or contracts with the supported HISP, Secure Exchange Solutions.	TTransport of the Summary of Care requires the use of MEDHOST supported HISP, Secure Exchange Solutions. MEDHOST supported HISP is a member of Direct Trust. Pursuant to MEDHOST security policy, the Direct messaging capability is restricted and users will be unable to exchange Summary of Care documents with users of third-party HISPs who are not a member of Direct Trust. Exchange with third party HISP who are not a member of Direct Trust requires a support ticket to be logged with MEDHOST requesting manual installation of required security certificates.	MEDHOST Enterprise adheres to CCDA 1.1 and ITI-41 XDS.b (Provide and Register Document Set) standards. Transport of the Summary of Care requires the use of a HISP. MEDHOST supported partner HISP is Secure Exchange Solutions.
e-Prescribe §170.314(b)(3)	MEDHOST EDIS electronically creates prescriptions and prescription related information for electronic transmission.	A one-time implementation service, license and recurring monthly maintenance fee apply based upon licensed beds.	Electronic prescription transmission is limited to pharmacies that subscribe to the Surescripts Network.	Requires the use of third party software Surescripts.
Transmission to Immunization Registries §170.314(f)(2)	MEDHOST EDIS electronically creates immunization information for electronic transmission	A one-time implementation service fee and a recurring monthly maintenance fee apply per interface. Additional fees may apply to meeting state registry requirements that are not consistent with ONC certification requirements. Any additional requirements imposed by local, state or federal immunization registries may not be supported by the base purchase of MEDHOST Enterprise and may require purchase of YourCareLink interface engine, which has one implementation, licensure and monthy support fees.	No contractual limitations	MEDHOST Connex provides basic electronic immunization capabilities, certified to the ONC 2014 Edition.
Transmission to public health agencies – syndromic surveillance §170.314(f)(3)	MEDHOST EDIS electronically creates syndrome-based public health surveillance information for electronic transmission to registries.	A one-time implementation service fee and recurring monthly maintenance fee apply per interface. Additional fees may apply to meet state registry requirements that are not consistent with ONC certification requirements. Any additional requirements imposed by local, state or federal immunization registries may not be supported by the base purchase of MEDHOST Enterprise and may require purchase of YourCareLink interface engine, which has one implementation, licensure and monthy support fees.
